



#### FGG BEST IN SHOW

Special rule for Best in Show class – the Grand Champion Buck, Doe, and Wether are eligible for the Best in Show class. In order to allow wethers to compete against bucks and does, reproduction systems are not to be considered while judging the Best in Show class. All three genders have an equal chance of winning.



### FGG Mini Myo Show (Saturday, July 9th A.M. & P.M.)

The Mini Myo Show is a show to honor the original, traditional (landrace) look of the Tennessee Fainting Goat back in the days of Jon Tinsley and Dr. Mayberry. Only **small scale** myotonic goats may enter. A maximum height of 21" for does and 23" for bucks. There is no minimum.

This show will be judged on the traditional representation of the goats, not as meat goats.
